



Covid Policy 2021

Due to the travel restrictions and the restrictions on charter trips caused by COVID-19, we have adjusted our booking guidelines for our guests and introduced increased flexibility. In 2020 we had to learn that many things can stand in the way of a successful charter trip. We cover these risks with our "Covid Policy 2021" - clear rules as part of the contract!

With our modified booking guidelines, we support you with bookings for 2021.

The safety and health of the charter guests, our employees and partners are a priority for four seasons yachting.

DISCOUNTS FOR EARLY BOOKING: (valid until January 31, 2021) *

-15% discount applies to one-week reservations.

-20% discount applies to reservations of two weeks or more

- Maximum discount 20%

** We reserve the right to extend the early bird discounts if necessary.*

PAYMENT:

For new reservations in 2021 until March 31, 2021: (last minute reservations are excluded from this section)

1. Payment:	20% of the charter price within a maximum of 7 working days
2. Payment:	30% of the charter price two months after booking
3. Payment:	50% of the charter price 28 days before travelling

As the payment terms have been made more flexible, it is very important that these payment terms are met. four seasons yachting reserves the right to cancel reservations that have not met the payment conditions as they are considered invalid reservations (terms and conditions).

CANCELLATIONS:

If the departure destination cannot be reached due to an impairment * of COVID-19, rebooking can be made free of charge to another destination or another date in 2021 or 2022. In the case of rescheduling, the new travel dates are subject to the current prices; in the case of more expensive bookings, the difference must be compensated, in the case of cheaper bookings there will be no refund.

In the event of an impairment, our team will contact you and inform you about a new plan.

** Travel warnings, quarantine and canceled flights do not count as travel restrictions, but we try to look at each case individually and find a solution with you.*
